THE WOUND

What is it inside boys that want to prove to their dad, "Im enough."

I'm strong enough. Please notice me, I'm becoming a man.

The root of our wound is this question:

Do you <u>love</u> me? Do I have <u>what it takes</u> to be a man?

Every man has a wound. Most of the time delivered by their father.

Its hard to heal what you don't reveal.

TABLE QUESTIONS ROUND 1

Inside each of us is still a <u>little boy</u>.

The little boy is afraid of:

- 1. Fear that I will fail.
- 2. Fear that I will be found out.
- 3. Fear that I am on my own.

Two areas that help identify the roots of our wound:

- 1. Our anger
- 2. Our addictions

A PRAYER

"Jesus take me into my wound. I give you permission and access to my soul and my deepest hurts. Come, and bring me to my own brokenness. Come and shepherd the orphaned boy within me. Let me be fully present to my wounded heart. Uncover my wound and meet me there."

TABLE QUESTIONS ROUND 2

STEP 1: SURRENDER Your Life to God.

CS Lewis: "Until you have given yourself to Him you will not have your real self."

STEP 2: Renounce THE VOW.

STEP 3: <u>INVITE</u> Jesus into our wound.

Isaiah 61:1-3:

The Spirit of the Sovereign Lord is on me, because the Lord has anointed me to proclaim good news to the poor. He has sent me to bind up the brokenhearted, to proclaim freedom for the captives and release from darkness for the prisoners, [a] ² to proclaim the year of the Lord's favor and the day of vengeance of our God, to comfort all who mourn, and provide for those who grieve in Zion to bestow on them a crown of beauty instead of ashes, the oil of joy instead of mourning, and a garment of praise instead of a spirit of despair.

STEP 4: _Allow yourself to <u>GRIEVE</u>.

SERIES: THE WOUND

St. Augustine, *The Confessions*: "The tears...streamed down, and I let them flow as freely as they would, making them a pillow for my heart. On them, it rested. Grief is a form of validation; it says the wound matters."

STEP 5: We let GOD love us.

Ephesians 3:16-19:

¹⁶ I pray that out of his glorious riches he may strengthen you with power through his Spirit in your inner being, ¹⁷ so that Christ may dwell in your hearts through faith. And I pray that you, being rooted and established in love, ¹⁸ may have power, together with all the Lord's holy people, to grasp how wide and long and high and deep is the love of Christ, ¹⁹ and to know this love that surpasses knowledge—that you may be filled to the measure of all the fullness of God.

STEP 6: We <u>FORGIVE</u> our fathers.

STEP 7: Ask God WHO YOU ARE as His son.

You are His <u>TRUE SON</u>. (1 John 3:1) You are completely <u>FORGIVEN</u> and <u>CLEANSED</u>. (1 John 1:9) Your sin nature has been <u>REMOVED</u>. (Romans 6:11; Colossians 2:11) Christ is now your <u>TRUE LIFE</u> and <u>NATURE</u>. (Ephesians 2:4-6) You have a new <u>NAME</u>. (Isaiah 62:2; Revelation 2:17)
